Full Instructions:

- 1. Gather materials as seen above.
- 2. Find and discuss the book and/ or link as seen above.
- 3. Make sure to cover your work surface with white piece of paper.
- 4. Use markers to color the coffee filter and design what you like using the markers –washable markers work much better.
- 5. Then, use the paint brush to paint water over the colored areas. (You can also use a spray bottle of water for a different look).
- 6. Let dry.

- 7. If you "paint" the coffee filter with a white piece of paper underneath, you'll find a second piece of Art when you're finished. The color will seep through the coffee filter on to the white paper and create a neat design.
- 8. When finished creating, you can hang them to display or create new projects with the pretty colored papers.
- 9. (5-12yr old option*) Instead of markers, use watercolor paints and brushes for detail.
